

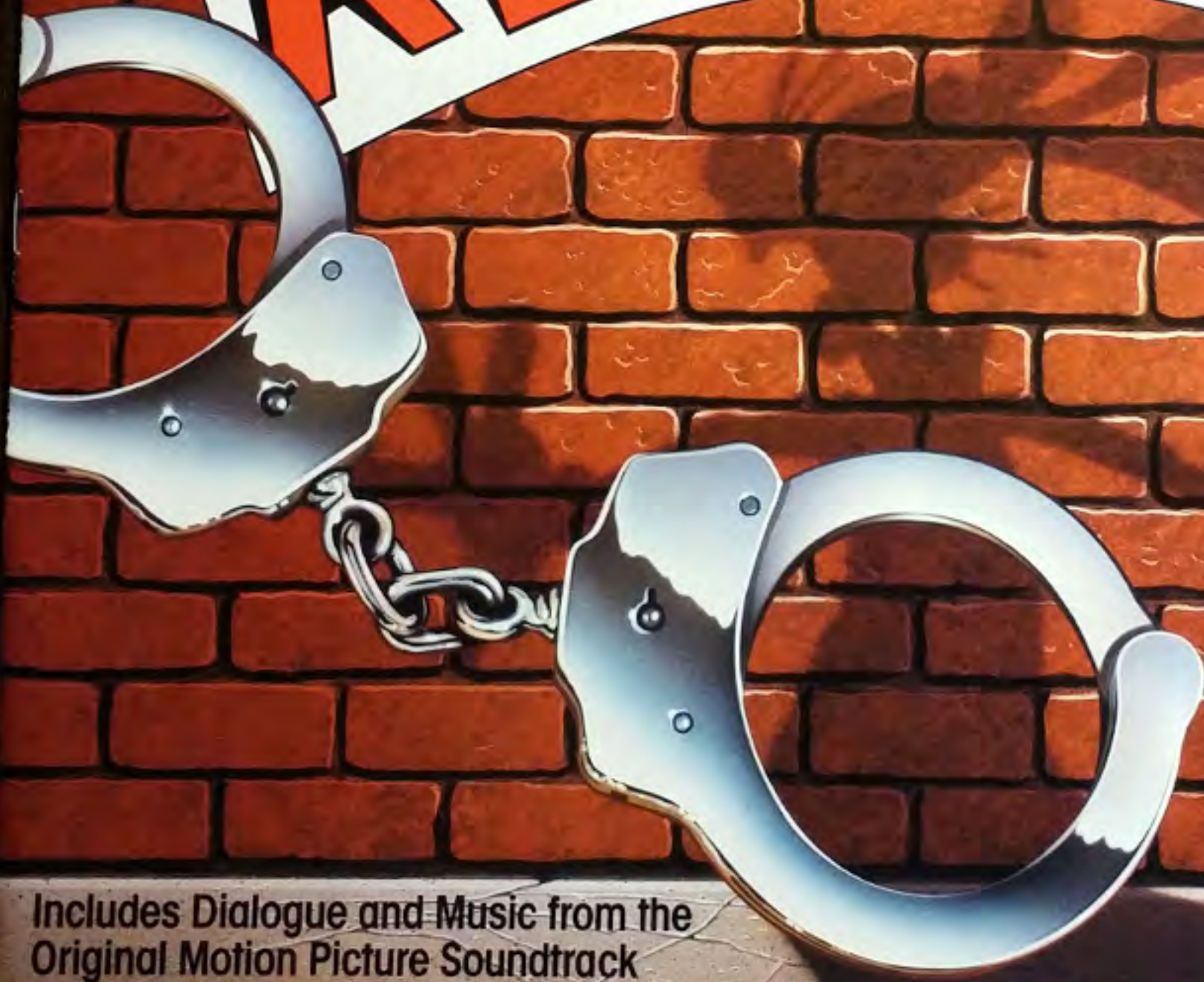

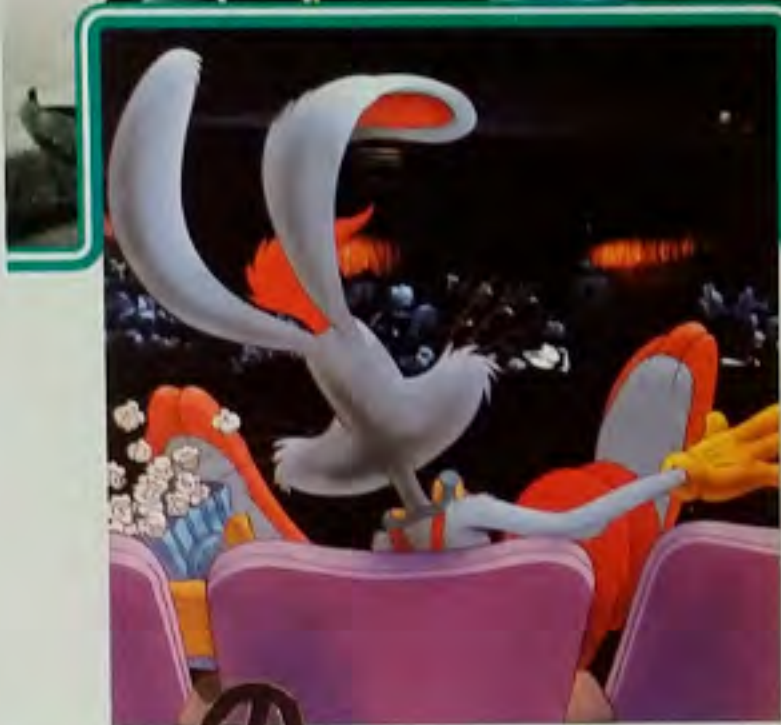

"Oh, no, the dip! I guess my goose is cooked, my hash is slung, my *fait is accompli!*"

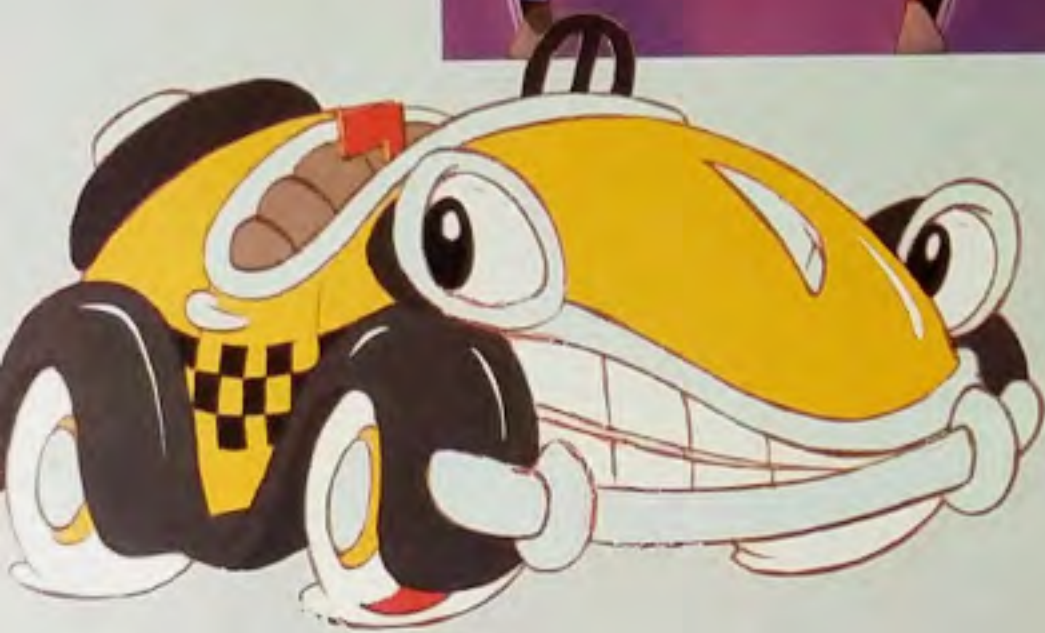


The weasels
